As of Monday, 9 February, Ets MOLLIEX FRERES will become MOLLIEX FRERES SAS, a subsidiary of HBP GROUP.

MOLLIEX FRERES had been in receivership since the end of 2025. At the end of this observation period, on Wednesday 4 February 2026, the Lyon Commercial Court decided to approve the takeover plan presented by HBP GROUP.
